It is the policy of Northminster Preschool to keep your child home if he/she displays any of the following symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4 degrees or higher
- Chills
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea two or more in a 24 hour period of time
- Congestion or runny nose
- Sore throat/Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Loss of taste or smell
- Ear ache
- Red itchy eyes and/or discharge coming from the eye(s)
- Red, raised rash on *any* part of the body
- Generally just not feeling well pale, lack of appetite, cranky, lethargic, etc.

I understand that if my child comes to school and is found to have any of the above listed symptoms, or develops these symptoms while at Preschool, I will be notified immediately and asked to pick up my child or arrange pick up within **30 minutes**. I also understand that these are not all inclusive symptoms. Other symptoms that may present themselves during the Preschool day, and become a concern of the Northminster Preschool staff, will still require my child to be picked up within 30 minutes.

_	I agree that if my child presents with one or more COVID symptoms (which includes most cold symptoms) that I
	will follow the current COVID-19 Decision Tree for Childcare published by the County of San Diego Health and
	Human Services Agency.

- I understand that I will contact Northminster Preschool **immediately** if my child has tested positive for COVID-19 or if anyone living in my house with my child has contracted COVID-19.
- I understand that mask guidance may change based on COVID numbers and it is up to the sole discretion of the Director on whether masks will be worn.
- I understand that if my child is exposed to anyone who has COVID, I will follow the Decision Tree's close contact quarantine requirements before my child can return to Preschool.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that the CDC and the State of California strongly recommend wearing a mask on indoor public transportion.
- By signing below, I declare that I understand this Health and Welfare Policy and agree to proceed accordingly. I understand that this policy is in place to protect the health and well being of all the children and staff of Northminster Preschool. Noncompliance is grounds for dismissal.
